



Mae Fah Luang University Notification
on the Regulations Regarding Undergraduate Students' English Proficiency
Development and Assessment Criteria of the Communicative English Subject
in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) 2022

Mae Fah Luang University has implemented a policy to provide undergraduate students with opportunities to develop their English proficiency throughout their studies. In addition to requiring certain courses as part of the curriculum, the university helps students to prepare for the Proficiency Examination before graduation so as to offer them more chances to succeed in this exam.

Enhancing students' English proficiency is an important requirement to achieve the university's vision to become a leading university in ASEAN with international recognition, as stated in its fifth development plan (2022-2026). As part of the first strategic objective (development of valuable human resources) and the fifth strategic objective (internationalization), Mae Fah Luang University considers that it is necessary to regulate the development of undergraduate students' English proficiency in 2022 by preparing them for the Communicative English Subject in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination).

Thus, pursuant to section 26 of the Mae Fah Luang University Act of 1998 and the approval of the Mae Fah Luang University Academic Council no. 9/2022 dated September 7th 2022, this notification is hereby issued as detailed hereunder.

1. This notification is referred to as "Mae Fah Luang University Notification on the Regulations Regarding Undergraduate Students' English Proficiency Development and Assessment Criteria of the Communicative English Subject in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) 2022."

2. This notification applies to undergraduate students entering Mae Fah Luang University in the academic year 2022 onwards.

3. Undergraduate students entering Mae Fah Luang University in the academic year 2022 onwards are required to improve their English skills by using the online English language learning program provided by the university every semester.

4. The undergraduate students who are not required to improve their English skills by using the online English language learning program provided by the university are those who have already received the symbol S from the Communicative English subject in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination).

5. The School of Liberal Arts is in charge of establishing the criteria for using the provided program as an assessment method of the Communicative English subject in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination). These criteria shall be announced each academic year. The School of Liberal Arts is also in charge of verifying the students' use of the program at the end of each semester and recording the scores earned by students in the Communicative English subject in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination).

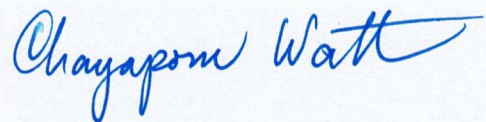
6. The assessment methods of the Communicative English subject in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) consist of the use of the online English language learning program (20%) and the Communicative English exam in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) administered by the Division of Registrar (80%).

7. Students are required to use the online English language learning program provided by the university, as stated in the Notification from the School of Liberal Arts, in order to gain up to 20 points (20% of the Communicative English Subject as mentioned in no. 6) as long as they are undergraduate students at Mae Fah Luang University.

Students who have already gained 20 points from using the online English language learning program but have not yet passed the Communicative English exam in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) administered by the Division of Registrar may continue to use the program, but they will not gain any additional points by using it.

8. The President of Mae Fah Luang University or the designated representative of the President shall have the power to decide on any issues related to or arising from this notification and such decision shall be final and binding.
