



Notification of School of Sinology

**Subject: Qualifications and Criteria for Transferring Students to the School of Sinology,
Mae Fah Luang University**

As the School of Sinology has been offering undergraduate programs in four majors, namely: the Bachelor of Arts program in Chinese Studies, the Bachelor of Arts program in Business Chinese, the Bachelor of Arts program in Chinese Language and Culture, and the Bachelor of Education program in Teaching Chinese Language.

In order to ensure the efficiency of the student transfer process and the management of teaching and learning, the board of the School of Sinology, during its meeting No. 12/2567 on December 12, 2024, approved the cancellation of the School of Sinology's Notification on the Criteria for Student Transfers on December 1, 2017. The board has decided to implement this new Notification on the Qualifications and Criteria for Student Transfers to the School of Sinology, as outlined below.

1. The student must be currently enrolled in any one of the University's programs and must have been registered in their current program for at least two regular semesters.

2. The student must have an academic performance with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 2.50.

3. The Teaching Chinese Language program does not accept transfer students due to the limitations imposed by the accreditation criteria for education degrees set by the Teachers Council of Thailand.

4. Students who wish to transfer must pass the following tests or follow the conditions below:

4.1 Students who wish to transfer to the Business Chinese program and the Chinese Language and Culture program must have a Chinese proficiency test score (HSK) of at least Level 3 with a score of 180, or must pass the school's own assessment test.

4.2 Students who wish to transfer to the Chinese Studies program must have a Chinese proficiency test score (HSK) of at least Level 4 with a score of 180, or must pass the school's own assessment test.

4.3 The student must undergo an interview with the lecturers of the program to which they are transferring.

5. The approval for transferring must be granted with the consent of the Board of the School of Sinology.

6. The curriculum of the new program currently used in which the transfer is requested must be applied.


7. The courses that have already been registered will be transferred to the new program's curriculum. Any courses that fall outside the new curriculum will be categorized as free electives.

8. A student will be approved to transfer only once.

For other criteria shall follow the regulations of Mae Fah Luang University regarding undergraduate education (No. 10), B.E. 2548, and the Mae Fah Luang University Notification on the Procedures for Program Transfers, B.E. 2547.
