



Mae Fah Luang University Announcement

Subject: The Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) Undergraduate Level B.E.2561 (Year 2018)

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Mae Fah Luang University has the policy to provide a proficiency examination before graduation (Exit Examination) for all undergraduate students in order to ensure the education quality of graduating students.

Therefore, in order to improve the rules and regulations of the proficiency examination before graduation and be effective, beneficial and appropriate to prepare graduates, and pursuant to section 26 of the Mae Fah Luang University Act of 1998 and the approval of the Mae Fah Luang University Academic Council no. 7/2018 dated 6th June, 2018, the announcement on the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) for the Undergraduate Level B.E.2560 (Year 2017) dated 12th October B.E.2560 (Year 2017) has been cancelled.

The announcement of the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) for Undergraduate Level B.E.2561 is issued as follows:

1 . This Announcement is referred to as “Mae Fah Luang University’s Announcement on the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination), Undergraduate Level B.E.2561 (Year 2018).”

2 . Every undergraduate student must pass the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination).

3 . An eligible student for the Exit Examination must have the following qualifications:

3.1 A student who has studied for at least six semesters;

3.2 A student who has a GPAX not less than 2.00 in the semester before the Exit Examination.

3.3 A student who has at least one of the following qualifications:

- 3.3.1 A student who is expected to graduate in the same semester that the exam is arranged; **OR**
- 3 .3 .2 A student who has enrolled in and completed all courses with the exception of Cooperative Education or Professional Experience, which will be enrolled in and completed the following semester; **OR**
- 3.3.3 A third-year student in the Bachelor of Nursing Science Program who has passed all general education courses required by the curriculum; **OR**
- 3.3.4 A student in the Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine program, Doctor of Medicine program or Doctor of Dental Surgery program who have studied in year 4 or above and have passed all general education courses required by the curriculum; **OR**
- 3 .3 .5 A student who has not passed all subjects for the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination).

Potential graduates without the aforementioned qualifications will be evaluated at the discretion of the School Committee to present to the Academic Council for approval.

4. There are 4 areas of content in the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination); they are as follows:

- 4.1. Communicative English
- 4.2. IT Literacy
- 4.3. Current Global Affairs
- 4.4. Knowledge and Application of Major Courses

5 . The Division of Registrar cooperates with schools to arrange the exit examinations for students who are expected to graduate: two times in the first semester, two times in the second semester, and two times in the summer semester.

6 . The students in the Bachelor of Nursing Science Program, Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine program, Doctor of Medicine program and Doctor of Dental Surgery program take the exit examinations in the areas of 4 .1 -4 .3 according to schedules arranged by the Division of Registrar. For area 4.4, the school will arrange the examination for those students who have passed all subjects required by the curriculum.

6.1 The students in the Bachelor of Nursing Science Program, Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine program and Doctor of Dental Surgery program, the school will

arrange the examination for area 4.4 when student has enrolled in and completed all courses required by the curriculum.

6.2 The students in the Bachelor of Doctor of Medicine program, the school will arrange the examination for area 4.4 when students have passed all courses required by the curriculum of the fifth year.

7. In order to pass the exit examination, a student must receive not less than 60 percent in each area.

8. Should the student fail the exit examination:

8.1 The student is eligible to retake the examination for the failed area(s) until s/he passes all areas.

8.2 If a student has completed the curriculum and received grade results for all courses, but s/he has not passed the exit examination, s/he must request to maintain his/her student status within the first two weeks of the next semester without paying a fee for status maintenance. However, the student must pay the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) fee, according to the Mae Fah Luang University announcement on the subject of the fee for the Proficiency Examination before Graduation (Exit Examination) B.E.2547, dated 27 September, 2004 B.E.2547.

9. This announcement is valid from the first semester of the academic year 2017.

10. For any conflicts concerning compliance with this announcement, the President shall have authority, and the decisions of the President shall be final.
