



Mae Fah Luang University's Announcement
Subject: The Enrollment Regulations for Undergraduates with GPAX below 2.00

The announcement of Mae Fah Luang University on the subject of "The Enrollment Regulations for Undergraduates Placed on Academic Probation" announced on the 22nd of January, 2007 was established for the undergraduates who were placed on academic probation to enroll the courses suiting their potential and return to good academic standing; however, the regulations did not cover year 1 undergraduates whose academic status was not classified.

In accordance with Article 26 of The Mae Fah Luang Act 1998 and in accordance with a resolution passed during the Academic Council meeting 12/2007 held on the 4th of December, 2007, it was decided that the announcement of Mae Fah Luang University on the subject of "The Enrollment Regulations for Undergraduates Placed on Academic Probation" announced on the 22nd of January, 2007 be cancelled and the announcement of Mae Fah Luang University on the subject of "The Enrollment Regulations for Undergraduates with GPAX below 2.00" be established. The announcement mandates the following:

1. The enrollment of undergraduates placed on academic probation must be approved by their advisors and must follow the regulations of a certain curriculum and the announcement of Mae Fah Luang University.
2. The number of credits the students are able to enroll is as follows.
 - 2.1 Up to 15 credits for each regular semester
 - 2.2 Up to 3 credits for summer school

The announcement is effective starting the first semester of the Academic Year 2551 onwards.
