



**Mae Fah Luang University's Rules
For Bachelor's Degree Education (Eight Issue), 2005**

To ensure effectiveness of Mae Fah Luang University's bachelor's degree education standards, in keeping with the university's academic objectives and philosophy, Mae Fah Luang University, empowered by Clause 17 (2) of Mae Fah Luang University Act 1998 and by Mae Fah Luang University Board of Trustees' resolution reached in meeting 3/2005 on 13 May 2005, hereby issues this rule.

1. This rule is referred to as 'Mae Fah Luang University Rules for Bachelor's Degree Education (Eighth Issue), 2005', hereinafter 'This Rule'.
2. This Rule is effective as of the first semester of the academic year 2005.
3. By This Rule, Clause 12.2.2 (3) of Section 7 and Clause 15.1 of Section 8 of Mae Fah Luang University's Rules for Bachelor's Degree Education, 1999, has been annulled and replaced with the following:

Section 7

Clause 12.2.2 Other than stated in Clause 12.2.1 above, an F grade may be given for the following reasons:

- (3) An I grade is not amended within the first two weeks of the immediately following semester, including the summer session.

Section 8

Clause 15.1 Classification of studentship status (normal vs probationary) is first done after a student has finished his/her second regular semester and shall be done at the end of every regular semester (hence excluding a summer session). Classification of studentship status may be done at the end of a summer session ONLY IF the student is expected to graduate or has fulfilled all of the degree
