



**Mae Fah Luang University Announcement**  
**Subject: Student Status Classification**  
**Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine year 2014.**

According to Mae Fah Luang University Regulations regarding undergrad education, B.E. 1999, item 15.1, "A student's status will first be classified at the end of the second semester of their first year. Afterwards, a student's status will be classified at the end of each semester or at the end of the summer semester for those students who have completed the curriculum and are qualified for graduation." However, the Traditional Chinese Medicine program differs from other programs. Prospective students of the Traditional Chinese Medicine program must have tested at a minimum of level 3 on the Chinese proficiency test (HSK). Students who score lower than level 3 or who do not have a score on the Chinese proficiency test must enroll in Chinese Foundation courses for 2 semesters before entering the first year of the Traditional Chinese Medicine program, as required by the curriculum.

Therefore, pursuant to section 26 of the Mae Fah Luang University Act of 1998 and the approval of the Mae Fah Luang University Academic Council no. 4/2014 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2014, the announcement regarding student status classification for students in the Traditional Chinese Medicine program has been announced as follows:

1. In the foundation year (the first two semesters), the student status of those who have not tested at level 3 on the Chinese proficiency test (HSK) is not classified. This is due to the fact that the students study in Chinese Foundation courses has yet to be credited to their status.

2. The student status will be classified at the end of the second semester of year one after enrolling in and completing required courses for which credits are counted according to the curriculum.

3. Students must have tested at a minimum of level 3 on the Chinese proficiency test (HSK) at the end of year one according to the curriculum's study plan which excludes the foundation year.

This announcement is applicable to the students of the Traditional Chinese Medicine program, academic year 2014 onwards.
