



**Mae Fah Luang University Regulation on  
Regalia, Academic Robes and Academic Pins,  
BE 2557 (2014), Second Issue**

Mae Fah Luang University considers that it is necessary to amend its Regulation on Regalia, Academic Robes and Academic Pins, BE 2546 (2003), to ensure greater clarity and appropriateness of its enforcement. Therefore, empowered by Article 17(2) of Mae Fah Luang University Act, BE 2551 (2008), and by consent of Mae Fah Luang University Board of Trustees given in meeting 5/2557 (2014) on 24 September 2014, Mae Fah Luang University hereby issues the amended section of the regulation.

- Item 1        This regulation is referred to as ‘Mae Fah Luang University Regulation on Regalia, Academic Robes and Academic Pins, BE 2557 (2014), Second Issue’.
- Item 2        This regulation is effective as of the date of issue.
- Item 3        Item 2 of Mae Fah Luang University Requirement on Regulation on Regalia, Academic Robes and Academic Pins, BE 2546 (2003), has been repealed and replaced with the following.

Item 2    In this requirement:

- ‘The President’        refers to    the president of Mae Fah Luang University;
- ‘The Board of Trustees’ refers to    the Board of Trustees of Mae Fah Luang University;
- ‘The Chairperson of therefers to    the Chairperson of the Board of Board of Trustees’        Trustees of Mae Fah Luang University;
- ‘The members of the    refers to    the members of the Board of Board of Trustees’        Trustees of Mae Fah Luang University;

'The administrators' refers to the people appointed to Mae Fah Luang University academic administration positions;

'The faculty' refers to full-time lecturers of Mae Fah Luang University, including programme-appointed lecturers and senior lecturers appointed by Mae Fah Luang University;

'Advisors to the Board of Trustees' refers to the people appointed as advisors to the Board of Trustees of Mae Fah Luang University

Item 4           Item 9 of Mae Fah Luang University Regulation on Regalia, Academic Robes and Academic Pins, BE 2546 (2003), has been repealed and replaced with the following.

Item 9           The regalia of the members of the Board of Trustees and for the Advisors to the Board of Trustees shall resemble that of the President, but shall be without the breast-chain and the red silk shoulder shawls.
